ABOUT THE SHOW

Genderqueer/transgender singer-sociologist Ari Agha (they/them) was 39 years old when they had to decide whether they were willing to risk their singing voice by taking testosterone (or T) as part of their gender transition. When you sing, you are the instrument. Your body produces the sounds you share. Since childhood, singing was how Ari connected with their emotions and with the world, but they could no longer bear constant misgendering, so they started taking T.

Key of T is an interactive music/theater performance that shares Ari's experience of singing voice transition with testosterone, revealing under-explored possibilities of voice for everyone, regardless of gender identity.

Written by and starring Ari, with Mackenzie Lyn Marr (she/her) on piano, and directed by Robert Farid Karimi (he/they), the show premiered at the 2024 International Gala Choruses Festival in Minneapolis and features the voices of everyone who shows up!

Come sing with Ari in this community celebration of genderful freedom, hard decisions, and queer liberation. Join us to hear yourself anew and be part of the choir!
